Annual Report (Financial Year 2025-2026)

Adamya Chetana Anantha Plate Bank

As a major stride toward environmental conservation, the Adamya Chetana organization has expanded its innovative initiative, the Anantha Plate Bank, to several cities, including Mysore and Bijapur in Karnataka, Dehradun in Uttarakhand, and Ayodhya in Uttar Pradesh. This initiative has contributed a lion's share toward the dream of a plastic-free India.

In the cultural capital of Mysore, the Anantha Plate Bank project was launched through a collaboration between Adamya Chetana and the GSS Yoga organization. The initiative was officially inaugurated on April 5, 2025, by the Member of Parliament for the Mysore Lok Sabha constituency, Shri Yaduveer Krishnadatta Chamaraja Wadiyar. Speaking on the occasion, Yaduveer Krishnadatta Wadiyar fondly recalled his previous visit to Adamya Chetana's zero-waste kitchen and highly praised the organization's eco-friendly endeavors. This particular plate bank commenced operations with an initial inventory of 2,000 reusable plates, tumblers, and spoons, aiming for the monumental goal of eliminating the use of single-use plastic and paper alternatives. The launch event was graced by Smt. Tejaswini Ananthakumar, Chairperson of Adamya Chetana, alongside Prof. P.V. Krishna Bhat, President of the Ananthakumar Foundation, Prof. Krishnegowda, Srihari of GSS organization, former Mayor Shivakumar, organization leaders, core volunteers, and various other dignitaries.

Expanding its footprint to Dehradun, Uttarakhand, Adamya Chetana established another branch of the Anantha Plate Bank in collaboration with the Nature Science Initiative (NSI), which was inaugurated by Smt. Tejaswini Ananthakumar on March 23, 2025. This marks the second plate bank established outside of Karnataka and the

very first in Uttarakhand, serving as a significant milestone in mitigating plastic usage and fostering environmental consciousness. Similarly, to commemorate the Diamond Jubilee of Sringeri Jagadguru Sri Sri Bharati Tirtha Mahaswamiji, an Anantha Plate Bank was inaugurated on April 13 in Sagara through a joint collaboration between the Sagara Shri Shankara Matha and Adamya Chetana. During this event, Smt. Tejaswini Ananthakumar led an interactive session titled "Green Kitchen and Nature Protection Dialogue," which saw active participation from environmentalist Shri Ananth Hegde, B.R. Jayanth, and several other prominent figures.

The green footprint was also extended to the holy city of Lord Rama. Previously, in line with the vision of the late Shri Ananthakumar, the Green Sunday (*Sasyagraha*) initiative had been expanded to Ayodhya, where 300 sacred Sita Ashoka saplings were planted along the banks of the Saryu River. Continuing its environmental conservation mission in Ayodhya, Adamya Chetana launched the Anantha Plate Bank on the auspicious occasion of Rama Navami on April 6, 2025. The project was formally inaugurated by Shri Gopal Ji, a prominent leader of the Vishva Hindu Parishad who is overseeing the construction of the Ram Mandir. The milestone event was witnessed by Smt. Tejaswini Ananthakumar, Adamya Chetana Trustee Shri Subramanyam, and other key representatives.
